Migrant Education Program (MEP) Goal

Address the unique educational needs of migratory children so that they have full and appropriate opportunities to meet the same academic standards as all other children.



Typical MEP Services

- ▶ Title I, Part C funds are used to serve migratory children ages 3-21 and their families.
- ▶ Services include instructional and support services:

Florida MEP Facts

- ▶ The State of Florida has the 5th largest migratory child population in the nation.
- ▶ Florida is considered a “home state” or “sending state” to many migrant families.
- ▶ Florida has 57 school districts:
 - ▶ 57 counties
 - ▶ 4 lab schools
 - ▶ 5 charter LEAs
 - ▶ FL School for the Deaf and the Blind
 - ▶ FL Virtual School

Florida MEP Facts

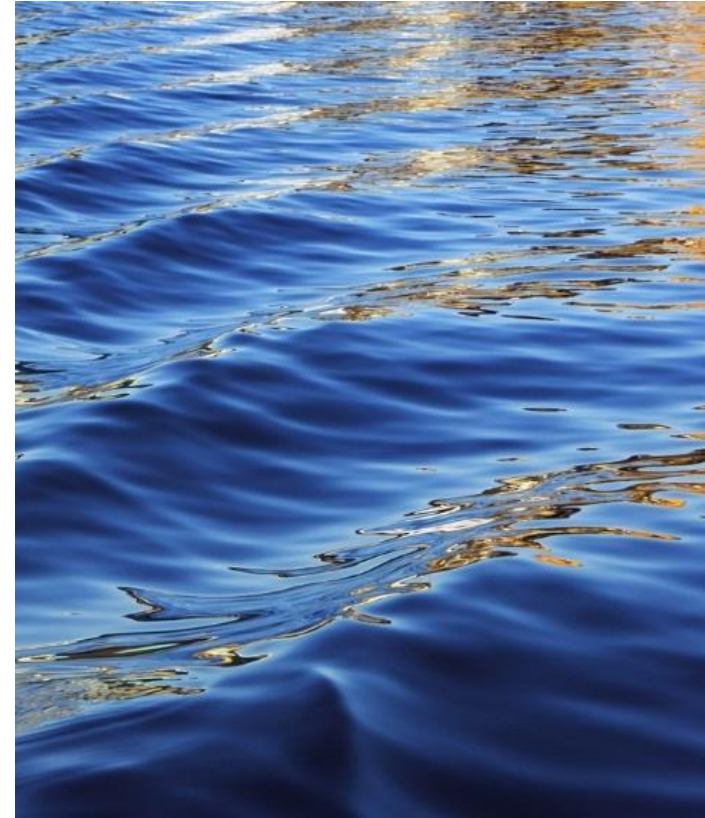
- ▶ Approximately 21,000 migrant children in FL.
- ▶ Approximately \$21 Million in MEP funds allocated to FL.
- ▶ 29 Local Educational Agencies/Local Operating Agencies receive FL Title I, Part C funds to serve 57 school districts
- ▶ Four state-level administrative offices:
 - ▶ University of South Florida (USF) Technical Assistance Project
 - ▶ Identification and Recruitment Office (ID&R)
 - ▶ Florida Migrant Parent Advisory Council (FMPAC)
 - ▶ Florida Migrant Interstate/Intrastate Program (FMIP)

Florida Migrant Interstate Program - FMIP

- ▶ Provides timely technical assistance throughout Florida and the nation regarding migrant student records transfers, transcript discrepancies and unresolved records transfer cases.
- ▶ Collaborates with other State Educational Agencies regarding migrant student records transfer.
- ▶ Primary contact for credit accrual issues and concerns to ensure timely transfer of academic and health records for individual migrant students, includes MSIX student records concerns.
- ▶ Maintains a database related to interstate activity to ensure quality services are provided to individual students in a timely manner.



MEP Interstate/Intrastate Coordination in Florida

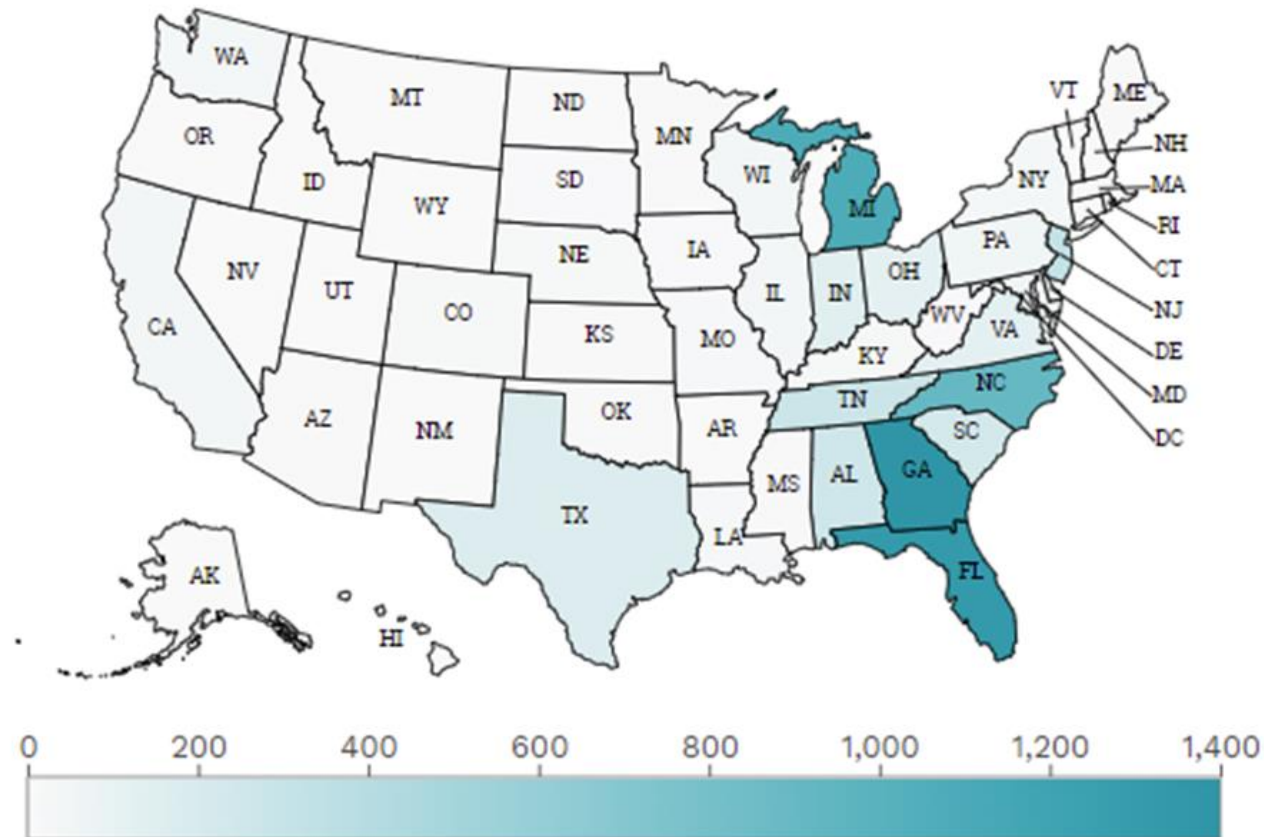
- ▶ Interstate/Intrastate coordination occurs at the local and state levels.
- ▶ We promote direct contact with our district coordinators to facilitate information exchange.
- ▶ We provide technical assistance on an ongoing basis.
- ▶ We develop agribusiness partnerships.

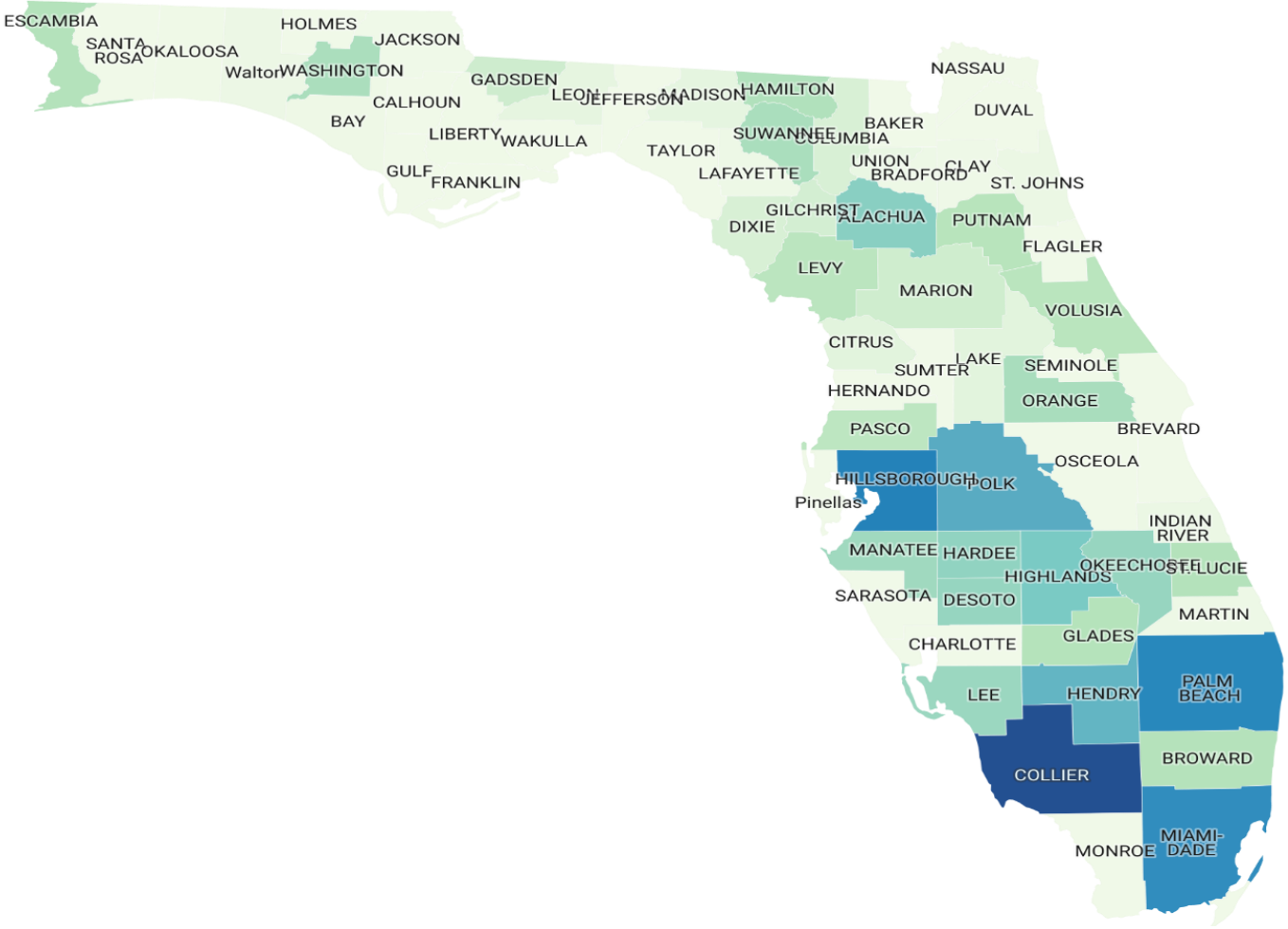
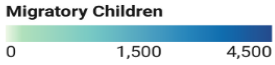

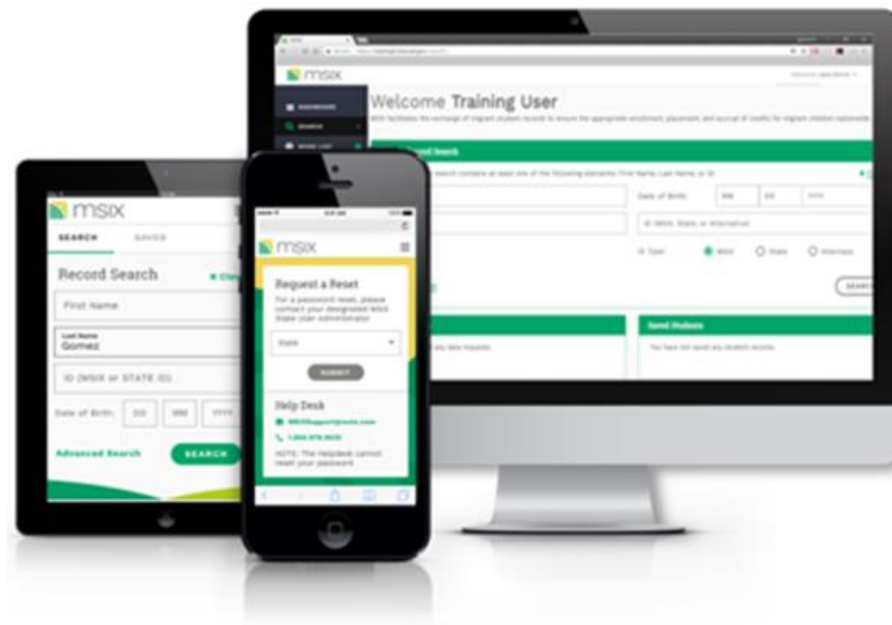

| Data Administrator | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Send, reply to, resolve, and reassign Data Requests• Send and reply to Move Notifications• Initiate and validate/reject near matches, merges, and splits of student records• Access to Reports | State, Regional, District |
| User Administrator | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Establish and manage user accounts for users in their region• Access to Account List Report | State, Regional |
| Primary User | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Initiate the merge and split process• Search student records from all States• Send/reply to Data Requests and Move Notifications• Access to Reports (limited) | State |
| Secondary User | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Search student records from all States• Send/reply to Data Requests and Move Notifications• Access to Reports (limited) | State |

- ▶ Liaisons who work with migratory students

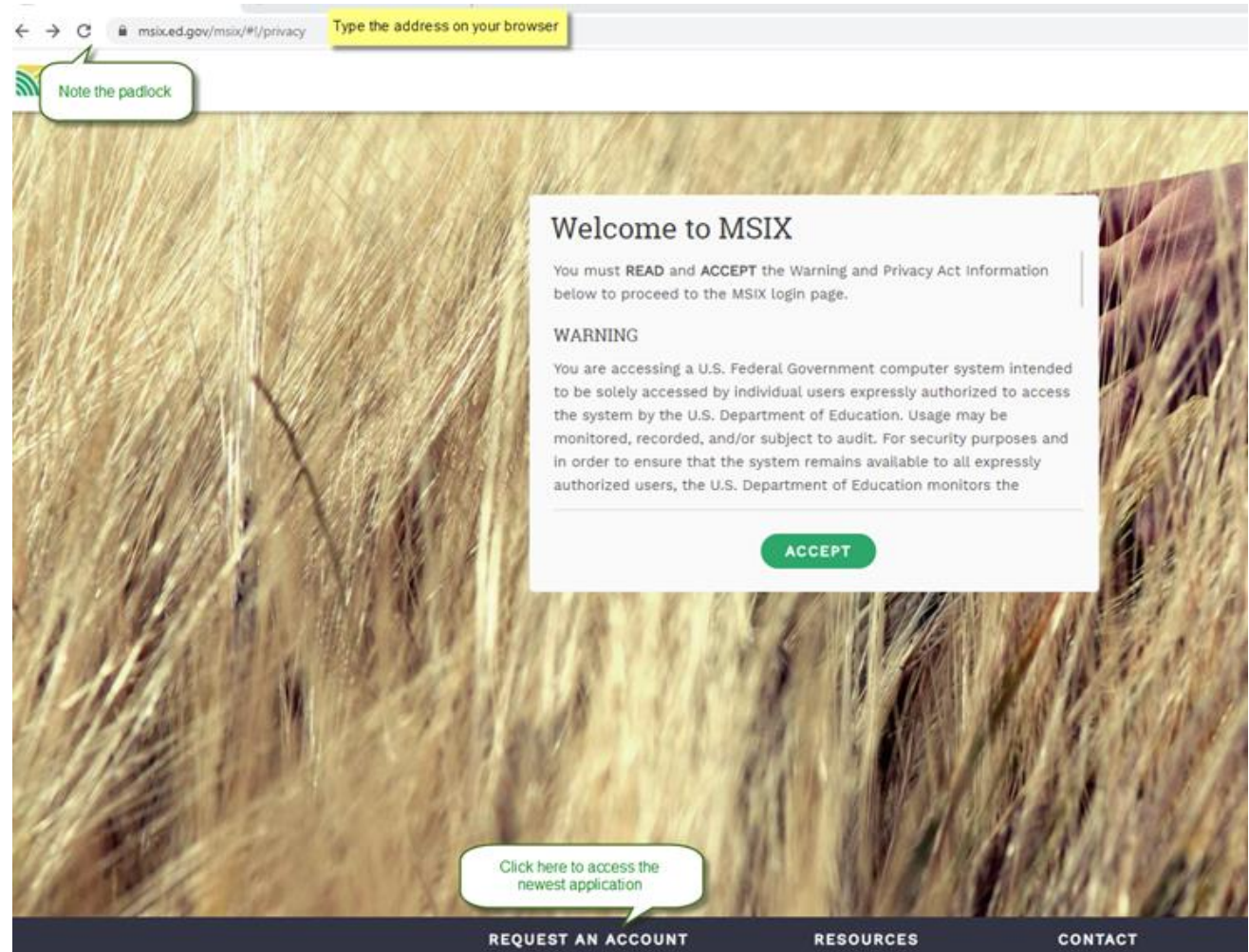


What Can You Do With MSIX?

- ▶ Receive and resolve move notifications
- ▶ Send move notifications
- ▶ Create data requests
- ▶ Accept and reject merge requests and near matches
- ▶ View consolidated student records
- ▶ View migratory history
- ▶ View and export reports
- ▶ Run reconciliation reports
- ▶ Verify data quality

How Do you Request an MSIX Account?

- ▶ Complete the application for MSIX user access
- ▶ Complete the cybersecurity webinar
- ▶ Send all completed applications and supporting documents to FMIP for processing
- ▶ Look for an email from the FMIP and MSIX with instructions on how to set up your password and security questions
